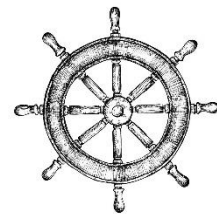
The cost of this field trip will be **\$6** per student, payable through SchoolCashOnline. (<https://www.schoolcashionline.com/>)
